

**Travel Documentation and Health Advisory
U.S. and Canadian Citizens**

PLEASE NOTE: In order to travel abroad, a valid passport is required for all U.S. and Canadian citizens. Most countries require that passports be valid for at least (6) months beyond the date of your return to the U.S. or Canada. Passports must have sufficient empty pages for visas that are required during the cruise. World Cruise travelers are recommended to have six (6) empty pages. **Please obtain or renew your passports early.** For information on obtaining or renewing a U.S. passport, visit the State Departments web site at: http://travel.state.gov/passport/passport_1738.html Canadian citizens visit www.ppt.gc.ca

These are the visa requirements for U.S. and Canadian passport holders who reside in the United States only. Guests holding non U.S. passports should check with their local country's consulates or Zierer Visa Service (ZVS) for their individual requirements. Entry requirements are subject to change at any time without advance notice from various governments. Please review the information to determine which countries require a visa and how those visas may be obtained. If you are a U.S. or Canadian passport holder residing in the U.S. and an independent visa is required, guests may download and print visa applications for any upcoming Regent Seven Seas cruise on Zierer Visa Services website. It is the responsibility of each guest to obtain the proper Visas, Passports and Inoculations for their cruise. Regent Seven Seas cruises will provide information only, but be aware that individual countries have been known to change regulations without notice.

Immunizations and health requirements vary by country. As these may also change without notice, we suggest you consult with your physician or local health department or contact the Center for Disease Control and Prevention at 1(800)232-4636 for the latest information.

Please remember it is extremely important to secure your visa prior to arrival for embarkation. Guests who deviate their embarkation or disembarkation port from the scheduled itinerary should research the foreign entry requirements for that country. Regrettably, Regent Seven Seas Cruises will, due to government regulations, have to deny boarding to any guest who fails to have the appropriate visas, inoculations and travel documentation.

Countries that require visas for Embarkation and Disembarkation:

Australia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Guests embarking, disembarking, in transit or participating in a pre/post land package in Australia MUST obtain an Electronic Travel Authority (ETA)
Brazil	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Guests embarking, disembarking or in transit in Brazil Must obtain a visa. All guests must submit a copy of their valid international Certificate of Yellow Fever vaccination with their Brazilian visa application. Guests must carry the original Yellow Fever Certificate onboard.
China	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Guests embarking in Hong Kong do not need a Chinese visa UNLESS they are participating in a pre-cruise mainland China land program. ■ Any itinerary that includes consecutive Chinese ports of call requires a <u>double entry</u> visa ■ When a post-cruise land program requires re-entry into mainland China a <u>multiple entry</u> is required.
India	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Guest embarking, disembarking, in transit, or participating in a pre/post land package MUST obtain a visa

Brazil	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Yellow Fever Inoculation - Guests must travel with their International Certificate of Vaccination or Revaccination Against Yellow Fever
Kenya	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Yellow Fever Inoculation - Guests must travel with their International Certificate of Vaccination or Revaccination Against Yellow Fever
Tanzania	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Yellow Fever Inoculation - Guests must travel with their International Certificate of Vaccination or Revaccination Against Yellow Fever
Benin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Yellow Fever Inoculation - Guests must travel with their International Certificate of Vaccination or Revaccination Against Yellow Fever ■ Malaria prophylaxis is recommended contact your physician for prescription
Togo	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Yellow Fever Inoculation - Guests must travel with their International Certificate of Vaccination or Revaccination Against Yellow Fever ■ Malaria prophylaxis is recommended contact your physician for prescription

Certain countries have established the requirement for "Transit/Entry Visas" The fees for these Transit/Entry visas are collected by the local authorities from the ship staff upon arrival. The countries below currently have such visas. For your convenience the charges for the visas have either been added to your cruise invoice or to your shipboard account. This service is provided on an optional basis if you prefer to pursue your visas independently please feel free to do so.

Kenya	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa cost is \$49 per person applicable to all Nationalities
Tanzania	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa cost is \$149 per person for U.S. Citizens: All other nationalities \$99 per person
Togo	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa cost is \$69 per person for U.S. Citizens: Canadian citizens \$89 per person: All other nationalities \$49 per person
Ghana	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa cost is \$149 per person applicable to all Nationalities
The Gambia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa cost is \$59 per person applicable to all Nationalities
Bahrain	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa cost is \$59 per person applicable to all Nationalities
Vietnam	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa cost is \$49 per person applicable to all Nationalities
Indonesia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa cost is \$49 per person applicable to all Nationalities
Myanmar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa cost is \$49 per person applicable to all Nationalities
Cambodia	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa cost is \$89 per person U.S. and Canadian Citizens
Turkey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visa cost is \$49 per person for U.S. Citizens and \$99 for Canadian Citizens. Turkish Visa are only required if cruise begins or ends in Turkey
