## **PARKWAY ASSEMBLY** LED BY PASTOR JOE WILLIAMS

#### Day 1 ~ Monday

Depart the United States flying overnight to Israel.

#### Day 2 ~ Tuesday

Arrive Ben Gurion Airport in **Tel Aviv**, directly on the **Mediterranean Sea** and **Israel's largest city**. Meet, assist and begin the journey traveling up the Israeli coastline to **Caesarea**, the **Roman capital of Judea**. View the beautiful restored **Roman Theater**, the **ruins of the ancient town**, **harbor** and **aqueduct**. Continue to the **Galilee** for overnight. *Galilee (D)* 

#### Day 3 ~ Wednesday

Morning visit to **Capernaum**, residence of Jesus during his ministry in the Galilee and the location of several of his miracles. Next, join together for a **special service** on the **waters of the Sea of Galilee**. Disembark and stop for a visit to the **ancient boat** at **Ginnosar**. Drive and view **Nazareth**, the **boyhood home of Jesus**. Continue across the **Jezreel Valley** to **Megiddo**, one of **Solomon's chariot cities** and the **site of the coming battle of Armageddon**. Conclude the day being **Baptized** in the **Jordan River**, at the beautiful site of **Yardenit**.

#### Day 4 ~ Thursday

Begin the day at the **Mount of Beatitudes**, the site of the **Sermon on the Mount**. With gifts in hand, proceed to a **border outpost to meet Israeli soldiers** who keep Israel safe along her northern border with Lebanon. Drive past the **Golan Heights**, site of the **former Syrian fortifications**. View the road to Damascus, passing **Mount Hermon**. Continue to **Caesarea Philippi** where Peter first professed Jesus as Christ and **Tabgha**, the traditional site of the **miracle of loaves and fishes** before returning to the **Galilee**.

#### Day 5 ~ Friday

This morning begin the journey up to Jerusalem, driving around the ancient city of **Jericho** en route. Enjoy a **welcome service** atop **Mount Scopus** upon arrival. View the beautiful panorama from atop the **Mount of Olives**, continuing to the **Garden of Gethsemane**. As the sun sets, gather at the **Western Wall (Kotel)** for the traditional bringing in of the **Sabbath**. Special **Shabbat dinner** at the hotel following check-in. *Jerusalem (B,D)* 

#### Day 6 ~ Saturday

Today's full adventure begins with a drive into the Judean wilderness around the ancient city of Jericho for a visit to Masada, the mountain top ruin of Herod's Palace and the last fortress of the Jewish revolt against Rome. Onto Qumran, overlooking the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered, followed by a swim in the Dead Sea. Return to Jerusalem.

#### Day 7 ~ Sunday

Following breakfast, walk through the **Western Wall Tunnels**, experiencing more than 2,000 years of history. Visit the **Pool** of Bethesda and St. Anne's Church. Walk atop ancient pavement to the Ecce Homo Archway. Follow the Stations of the Cross (Via Dolorosa), through narrow alleys and souks to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. This afternoon, depart to Bethlehem, the traditional site of the birth of Jesus. Visit the Church of the Nativity, the Shepherd's Field and Manger Square. Late afternoon return to Jerusalem.

#### Day 8 ~ Monday

Ascend Mount Zion this morning, visiting St. Peter in Gallicantu Church overlooking the Kidron Valley and Caiaphas' House. Enter the walled city through Zion Gate visiting the Upper Room of the Last Supper. Continue to the restored Jewish Quarter with its Roman Cardo. Experience Ir David, the City of David with an exciting journey both above and below ground through excavations, fortresses and passageways, walking through the Canaanite tunnel. Onto the Davidson's Visitor Center in the Southern Wall Archaeological Garden. *Jerusalem (B,D)*

#### Day 9 ~ Tuesday

# Begin your last day in Jerusalem with communion at the Garden Tomb. Remainder of the day will be spent in the New City of Jerusalem. Drive to the Shrine of the Book at the Israel Museum, where the Dead Sea Scrolls are housed. View the Model of Ancient Jerusalem, a miniature of the city during the Second Temple period. Next, view Israel's Parliament Knesset grounds en route to the Memorial to the Holocaust at Yad Vashem. Conclude the tour with a visit to the Friends of Zion Museum, dedicated to the outstanding contributions of Christians to the State of Israel. Enjoy a special Farewell Dinner at the hole.

#### Day 10 ~ Wednesday

#### Petra / En Route

Early morning departure to the airport for the flight to **Eilat.** Drive to **Arava border** for crossing over into Jordan with assistance through border procedures. Drive to **Petra** for a visit. Walk through the **Siq** and explore highlights of this ancient Nabatean city: **the Treasury the theater, the tombs and facades and the colonnaded street**. Following lunch, drive back to the Arava Border and cross back into Israel and transfer to Eilat Airport for return flight to Ben Gurion Airport. Meet and assistance in departure at airport for flight to the United States.

**Day 11 ~ Thursday** Arrival in the **United States**.
