REAL ID Act Compliance

State-issued IDs that are not REAL ID-compliant cannot be used to board domestic commercial flights within the US beginning October 1, 2020.

Beginning October 1, 2020 travelers boarding domestic commercial flights within the United States and its territories will be required to present a state-issued ID compliant with the REAL ID Act at all Transportation Security Administration (TSA) security checkpoints. If a state-issued ID (e.g., driver's license) does not comply with the REAL ID Act, an alternate form of identification will be required by the TSA in order to board a domestic flight.

All US states are now considered compliant, with the exception of Oregon, Oklahoma, New Jersey and Maine, which have been granted extensions through October 10, 2019. IDs from non-compliant states will not be accepted for boarding commercial aircraft beginning October 10, 2019, unless an extension is granted. NOT ALL STATE-ISSUED IDS ARE REAL ID-COMPLIANT!

Please note, not all recently issued state IDs are REAL ID compliant. REAL ID compliant cards are generally marked with a star located in the upper portion of the card. Even if you live in a state that is compliant, you will need to ensure your state-issued ID is REAL ID-compliant. If it is not compliant, and you are traveling after October 1, 2020; you must bring an alternative form of ID, such as a passport, to board a domestic flight.

In most states, you must be physically present to obtain a REAL ID license, and states will not issue you a REAL ID-compliant license automatically. While many states are issuing compliant IDs, individuals are still required to upgrade the security of their license.
